Every day, American families produce an estimated 4 million pounds of household hazardous waste (nail polish, paint thinner, batteries, etc).

The average home can accumulate as much as 100 pounds of hazardous waste. This material is often improperly stored in sheds, garages, and basements, placed in landfills, or worse, discarded down stormwater drains or dumped along roadsides or on vacant lands, which ultimately may result in contamination of our rivers, lakes and streams.
